

HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 2022-4667, by Representatives Sullivan and Kretz

1 WHEREAS, It is necessary to provide for the continuation of the
2 work of the House of Representatives after its adjournment and during
3 the interim periods between legislative sessions;

4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Executive Rules
5 Committee may assign subject matters, bills, memorials, and
6 resolutions to authorized committees of the House of Representatives
7 for study during the interim, and the Speaker of the House of
8 Representatives may create special and select committees as may be
9 necessary to carry out the functions, including interim studies, of
10 the House of Representatives in an orderly manner and shall appoint
11 members to such committees with the approval of the Executive Rules
12 Committee; and

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That, during the interim, the schedules,
14 agendas, locations, and formats for all meetings of any legislative
15 task force, committee, or subcommittee shall be approved by the
16 Executive Rules Committee, and those task forces, committees, or
17 subcommittees may conduct hearings and scheduling without a quorum
18 being present; and

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That, during the interim, the Executive
20 Rules Committee may authorize committee meetings to be conducted in
21 person or in remote or hybrid formats. When participating remotely in
22 any committee meeting, members shall be considered present for
23 purposes of a quorum and voting; and

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That, during the interim, authorized
2 committees have the power of subpoena, the power to administer oaths,
3 and the power to issue commissions for the examination of witnesses
4 in accordance with chapter 44.16 RCW if and when specifically
5 authorized by the Executive Rules Committee for specific purposes and
6 specific subjects; and

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Chief Clerk of the House of
8 Representatives shall complete the work of the 2022 Regular Session
9 of the Sixty-Seventh Legislature during interim periods, and all
10 details that arise therefrom, including the editing, indexing, and
11 publishing of the journal of the House of Representatives; and

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Chief Clerk of the House of
13 Representatives shall make the necessary inventory of furnishings,
14 fixtures, and supplies; and

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Chief Clerk of the House of
16 Representatives may approve vouchers of the members of the House of
17 Representatives, covering expenses incurred during the interim for
18 official business of the Legislature in accordance with policies set
19 by the Executive Rules Committee, at the per diem rate provided by
20 law and established by the Executive Rules Committee, for each day or
21 major portion of a day, plus mileage at the rate provided by law and
22 established by the Executive Rules Committee; and

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Chief Clerk of the House of
24 Representatives shall, during the interim, and as authorized by the
25 Speaker of the House of Representatives, retain or hire any necessary
26 employees and order necessary supplies, equipment, and printing to
27 enable the House of Representatives to carry out its work promptly
28 and efficiently, and accept committee reports, committee bills,
29 prefiled bills, memorials, and resolutions as directed by the Rules
30 of the House of Representatives; and

31 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Chief Clerk of the House of
32 Representatives shall have authority to execute personal services
33 contracts relating to workplace investigations, and with approval of
34 the Executive Rules Committee, may execute other types of personal
35 services contracts that necessitate the expenditure of House of
36 Representatives appropriations; and

37 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Chief Clerk of the House of
38 Representatives shall execute the necessary vouchers upon which

1 warrants are drawn for all legislative expenses and expenditures of
2 the House of Representatives; and

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That members and employees of the
4 Legislature be reimbursed for expenses incurred in attending
5 authorized conferences and meetings at the rate provided by law and
6 established by the Executive Rules Committee, plus mileage to and
7 from the conferences and meetings at the rate provided by law and
8 established by the Executive Rules Committee, which reimbursement
9 shall be paid on vouchers from any appropriation made to the House of
10 Representatives for legislative expenses; and

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That, during the interim, the use of the
12 House of Representatives Chamber, any of its committee rooms, or any
13 of the furniture or furnishings in them is permitted upon such terms
14 and conditions as the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives
15 shall deem appropriate; and

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Chief Clerk of the House of
17 Representatives may express the sympathy of the House of
18 Representatives by sending flowers and correspondence when the
19 necessity arises; and

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this Resolution applies throughout
21 the interim between sessions of the Sixty-Seventh Legislature, as
22 well as any committee assembly.
