## SENATE BILL 5059

State of Washington 65th Legislature 2017 Regular Session

**By** Senators O'Ban, Fortunato, Rivers, Miloscia, Brown, Warnick, Honeyford, and Padden

AN ACT Relating to motor vehicle property offenses; amending RCW 9.94A.525; reenacting and amending RCW 9.94A.515; and prescribing penalties.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 Sec. 1. RCW 9.94A.525 and 2013 2nd sp.s. c 35 s 8 are each 6 amended to read as follows:

7 The offender score is measured on the horizontal axis of the 8 sentencing grid. The offender score rules are as follows:

9 The offender score is the sum of points accrued under this 10 section rounded down to the nearest whole number.

(1) A prior conviction is a conviction which exists before the date of sentencing for the offense for which the offender score is being computed. Convictions entered or sentenced on the same date as the conviction for which the offender score is being computed shall be deemed "other current offenses" within the meaning of RCW 9.94A.589.

17 (2)(a) Class A and sex prior felony convictions shall always be 18 included in the offender score.

(b) Class B prior felony convictions other than sex offenses shall not be included in the offender score, if since the last date of release from confinement (including full-time residential

1 treatment) pursuant to a felony conviction, if any, or entry of 2 judgment and sentence, the offender had spent ten consecutive years 3 in the community without committing any crime that subsequently 4 results in a conviction.

5 (c) Except as provided in (e) of this subsection, class C prior 6 felony convictions other than sex offenses shall not be included in 7 the offender score if, since the last date of release from 8 confinement (including full-time residential treatment) pursuant to a 9 felony conviction, if any, or entry of judgment and sentence, the 10 offender had spent five consecutive years in the community without 11 committing any crime that subsequently results in a conviction.

12 (d) Except as provided in (e) of this subsection, serious traffic convictions shall not be included in the offender score if, since the 13 14 last date of release from confinement (including full-time residential treatment) pursuant to a conviction, if any, or entry of 15 16 judgment and sentence, the offender spent five years in the community 17 without committing any crime that subsequently results in а 18 conviction.

(e) If the present conviction is felony driving while under the 19 influence of intoxicating liquor or any drug (RCW 46.61.502(6)) or 20 21 felony physical control of a vehicle while under the influence of intoxicating liquor or any drug (RCW 46.61.504(6)), all predicate 22 crimes for the offense as defined by RCW 46.61.5055(14) shall be 23 included in the offender score, and prior convictions for felony 24 25 driving while under the influence of intoxicating liquor or any drug (RCW 46.61.502(6)) or felony physical control of a vehicle while 26 under the influence of intoxicating liquor or any drug (RCW 27 46.61.504(6)) shall always be included in the offender score. All 28 other convictions of the defendant shall be scored according to this 29 section. 30

(f) Prior convictions for a repetitive domestic violence offense, as defined in RCW 9.94A.030, shall not be included in the offender score if, since the last date of release from confinement or entry of judgment and sentence, the offender had spent ten consecutive years in the community without committing any crime that subsequently results in a conviction.

37 (g) This subsection applies to both adult and juvenile prior 38 convictions.

39 (3) Out-of-state convictions for offenses shall be classified40 according to the comparable offense definitions and sentences

1 provided by Washington law. Federal convictions for offenses shall be 2 classified according to the comparable offense definitions and 3 sentences provided by Washington law. If there is no clearly 4 comparable offense under Washington law or the offense is one that is 5 usually considered subject to exclusive federal jurisdiction, the 6 offense shall be scored as a class C felony equivalent if it was a 7 felony under the relevant federal statute.

8 (4) Score prior convictions for felony anticipatory offenses 9 (attempts, criminal solicitations, and criminal conspiracies) the 10 same as if they were convictions for completed offenses.

(5)(a) In the case of multiple prior convictions, for the purpose of computing the offender score, count all convictions separately, except:

(i) Prior offenses which were found, under RCW 9.94A.589(1)(a), 14 to encompass the same criminal conduct, shall be counted as one 15 offense, the offense that yields the highest offender score. The 16 17 current sentencing court shall determine with respect to other prior 18 adult offenses for which sentences were served concurrently or prior juvenile offenses for which sentences were served consecutively, 19 whether those offenses shall be counted as one offense or as separate 20 offenses using the "same criminal conduct" analysis found in RCW 21 9.94A.589(1)(a), and if the court finds that they shall be counted as 22 one offense, then the offense that yields the highest offender score 23 shall be used. The current sentencing court may presume that such 24 25 other prior offenses were not the same criminal conduct from sentences imposed on separate dates, or in separate counties or 26 jurisdictions, or in separate complaints, indictments, or 27 informations; 28

(ii) In the case of multiple prior convictions for offenses committed before July 1, 1986, for the purpose of computing the offender score, count all adult convictions served concurrently as one offense, and count all juvenile convictions entered on the same date as one offense. Use the conviction for the offense that yields the highest offender score.

35 (b) As used in this subsection (5), "served concurrently" means 36 that: (i) The latter sentence was imposed with specific reference to 37 the former; (ii) the concurrent relationship of the sentences was 38 judicially imposed; and (iii) the concurrent timing of the sentences 39 was not the result of a probation or parole revocation on the former 40 offense. 1 (6) If the present conviction is one of the anticipatory offenses 2 of criminal attempt, solicitation, or conspiracy, count each prior 3 conviction as if the present conviction were for a completed offense. 4 When these convictions are used as criminal history, score them the 5 same as a completed crime.

6 (7) If the present conviction is for a nonviolent offense and not 7 covered by subsection (11), (12), or (13) of this section, count one 8 point for each adult prior felony conviction and one point for each 9 juvenile prior violent felony conviction and 1/2 point for each 10 juvenile prior nonviolent felony conviction.

(8) If the present conviction is for a violent offense and not covered in subsection (9), (10), (11), (12), or (13) of this section, count two points for each prior adult and juvenile violent felony conviction, one point for each prior adult nonviolent felony conviction, and 1/2 point for each prior juvenile nonviolent felony conviction.

(9) If the present conviction is for a serious violent offense, count three points for prior adult and juvenile convictions for crimes in this category, two points for each prior adult and juvenile violent conviction (not already counted), one point for each prior adult nonviolent felony conviction, and 1/2 point for each prior juvenile nonviolent felony conviction.

(10) If the present conviction is for Burglary 1, count prior convictions as in subsection (8) of this section; however count two points for each prior adult Burglary 2 or residential burglary conviction, and one point for each prior juvenile Burglary 2 or residential burglary conviction.

(11) If the present conviction is for a felony traffic offense 28 count two points for each adult or juvenile prior conviction for 29 Vehicular Homicide or Vehicular Assault; for each felony offense 30 31 count one point for each adult and 1/2 point for each juvenile prior conviction; for each serious traffic offense, other than those used 32 for an enhancement pursuant to RCW 46.61.520(2), count one point for 33 each adult and 1/2 point for each juvenile prior conviction; count 34 one point for each adult and 1/2 point for each juvenile prior 35 36 conviction for operation of a vessel while under the influence of 37 intoxicating liquor or any drug.

38 (12) If the present conviction is for homicide by watercraft or 39 assault by watercraft count two points for each adult or juvenile 40 prior conviction for homicide by watercraft or assault by watercraft;

1 for each felony offense count one point for each adult and 1/2 point 2 for each juvenile prior conviction; count one point for each adult 3 and 1/2 point for each juvenile prior conviction for driving under 4 the influence of intoxicating liquor or any drug, actual physical 5 control of a motor vehicle while under the influence of intoxicating 6 liquor or any drug, or operation of a vessel while under the 7 influence of intoxicating liquor or any drug.

the present conviction is for manufacture 8 (13)If of methamphetamine count three points for each adult prior manufacture 9 of methamphetamine conviction and two points for each juvenile 10 manufacture of methamphetamine offense. If the present conviction is 11 12 for a drug offense and the offender has a criminal history that includes a sex offense or serious violent offense, count three points 13 for each adult prior felony drug offense conviction and two points 14 for each juvenile drug offense. All other adult and juvenile felonies 15 16 are scored as in subsection (8) of this section if the current drug 17 offense is violent, or as in subsection (7) of this section if the 18 current drug offense is nonviolent.

19 (14) If the present conviction is for Escape from Community 20 Custody, RCW 72.09.310, count only prior escape convictions in the 21 offender score. Count adult prior escape convictions as one point and 22 juvenile prior escape convictions as 1/2 point.

(15) If the present conviction is for Escape 1, RCW 9A.76.110, or
Escape 2, RCW 9A.76.120, count adult prior convictions as one point
and juvenile prior convictions as 1/2 point.

(16) If the present conviction is for Burglary 2 or residential burglary, count priors as in subsection (7) of this section; however, count two points for each adult and juvenile prior Burglary 1 conviction, two points for each adult prior Burglary 2 or residential burglary conviction, and one point for each juvenile prior Burglary 2 or residential burglary conviction.

32 (17) If the present conviction is for a sex offense, count priors 33 as in subsections (7) through (11) and (13) through (16) of this 34 section; however count three points for each adult and juvenile prior 35 sex offense conviction.

36 (18) If the present conviction is for failure to register as a 37 sex offender under RCW 9A.44.130 or 9A.44.132, count priors as in 38 subsections (7) through (11) and (13) through (16) of this section; 39 however count three points for each adult and juvenile prior sex 40 offense conviction, excluding prior convictions for failure to

1 register as a sex offender under RCW 9A.44.130 or 9A.44.132, which 2 shall count as one point.

3 (19) If the present conviction is for an offense committed while 4 the offender was under community custody, add one point. For purposes 5 of this subsection, community custody includes community placement or 6 postrelease supervision, as defined in chapter 9.94B RCW.

7 (20) If the present conviction is for Theft of a Motor Vehicle, Possession of a Stolen Vehicle, Taking a Motor Vehicle Without 8 Permission 1, ((or)) Taking a Motor Vehicle Without Permission 2, 9 Malicious Mischief 1 (motor vehicle), or Malicious Mischief 2 (motor 10 vehicle), count priors as in subsections (7) through (18) of this 11 12 section; however count one point for prior convictions of Vehicle Prowling 2, and three points for each adult and juvenile prior Theft 13 14 1 (of a motor vehicle), Theft 2 (of a motor vehicle), Possession of Stolen Property 1 (of a motor vehicle), Possession of Stolen Property 15 16 2 (of a motor vehicle), Theft of a Motor Vehicle, Possession of a 17 Stolen Vehicle, Taking a Motor Vehicle Without Permission 1, ((or)) Taking a Motor Vehicle Without Permission 2, Malicious Mischief 1 18 19 (motor vehicle), or Malicious Mischief 2 (motor vehicle) conviction.

(21) If the present conviction is for a felony domestic violence offense where domestic violence as defined in RCW 9.94A.030 was ((plead [pleaded])) pleaded and proven, count priors as in subsections (7) through (20) of this section; however, count points as follows:

25 (a) Count two points for each adult prior conviction where 26 domestic violence as defined in RCW 9.94A.030 was ((plead [pleaded])) pleaded and proven after August 1, 2011, for the following offenses: 27 A violation of a no-contact order that is a felony offense, a 28 29 violation of a protection order that is a felony offense, a felony domestic violence harassment offense, a felony domestic violence 30 31 stalking offense, a domestic violence Burglary 1 offense, a domestic violence Kidnapping 1 offense, a domestic violence Kidnapping 2 32 offense, a domestic violence unlawful imprisonment offense, a 33 domestic violence Robbery 1 offense, a domestic violence Robbery 2 34 offense, a domestic violence Assault 1 offense, a domestic violence 35 36 Assault 2 offense, a domestic violence Assault 3 offense, a domestic violence Arson 1 offense, or a domestic violence Arson 2 offense; 37

(b) Count one point for each second and subsequent juvenileconviction where domestic violence as defined in RCW 9.94A.030 was

1 ((plead [pleaded])) pleaded and proven after August 1, 2011, for the 2 offenses listed in (a) of this subsection; and

3 (c) Count one point for each adult prior conviction for a 4 repetitive domestic violence offense as defined in RCW 9.94A.030, 5 where domestic violence as defined in RCW 9.94A.030, was ((<del>plead</del> 6 <del>[pleaded]</del>)) <u>pleaded</u> and proven after August 1, 2011.

(22) The fact that a prior conviction was not included in an 7 offender's offender score or criminal history at a previous 8 sentencing shall have no bearing on whether it is included in the 9 criminal history or offender score for the current offense. Prior 10 convictions that were not counted in the offender score or included 11 12 in criminal history under repealed or previous versions of the sentencing reform act shall be included in criminal history and shall 13 count in the offender score if the current version of the sentencing 14 reform act requires including or counting those convictions. Prior 15 16 convictions that were not included in criminal history or in the 17 offender score shall be included upon any resentencing to ensure imposition of an accurate sentence. 18
