- 1 AN ACT Relating to creating a bi-state partnership for teachers of

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that Washington needs
- 6 to provide additional resources for the preparation of teachers for
- 7 children with blindness and visual impairments. The legislature
- 8 further finds that Portland State University has a nationally
- 9 recognized program for teachers of children with visual impairments and
- 10 that a collaborative partnership between Portland State University and
- 11 Washington State University-Vancouver would help address the critical
- 12 need for teachers of the blind and visually impaired in Washington.
- 13 The legislature intends to provide a vision impairments/orientation and
- 14 mobility coordinator to be housed at Washington State University-
- 15 Vancouver.
- 16 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 28B.30 RCW
- 17 to read as follows:
- 18 (1) Washington State University shall establish the position of

- vision impairments/orientation and mobility coordinator, to the extent that state funds are appropriated or that private or federal funds are available for this specific purpose. The coordinator shall be housed at Washington State University-Vancouver, and shall:
 - (a) Recruit Washington students for preparation as teachers for children who are blind or visually impaired;
 - (b) Develop partnerships with school districts with Washington schools that provide services to children who are blind or visually impaired;
- 10 (c) Supervise enrolled students and coordinate experiences with 11 mentor teachers;
- 12 (d) Coordinate and instruct in the orientation and mobility summer 13 curriculum as an adjunct faculty;
 - (e) Serve as a liaison between Portland State University and Washington State University-Vancouver; and
 - (f) Seek grants and independent funding sources for the program.
 - (2) Washington State University may solicit, accept, receive, and administer federal funds or private funds, in trust or otherwise, and contract with foundations or with for-profit or nonprofit organizations to support the purposes of this section.
