- AN ACT Relating to the use of bisphenol A; adding a new chapter to 1

- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 Beginning July 1, 2010, no manufacturer, NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. 5 wholesaler, or retailer may manufacture, knowingly sell, offer for sale, distribute for sale, or distribute for use in this state any 6 bottle or cup that contains bisphenol A and is designed or intended to be filled with any liquid, food, or beverage primarily for consumption 8 9 from that container by children three years of age or younger and is
- 10 sold or distributed without containing any liquid, food, or beverage.
- 11 (1) A manufacturer of products that are NEW SECTION. Sec. 2.
- 12 restricted under this chapter must notify persons that sell the
- 13 manufacturer's products in this state about the provisions of this 14 chapter no less than ninety days prior to the effective date of the
- restrictions. 15
- 16 (2) A manufacturer that produces, sells, or distributes a product
- 17 prohibited from manufacture, sale, or distribution in this state under

- this chapter shall recall the product and reimburse the retailer or any other purchaser for the product.
- 3 NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. (1) A manufacturer, wholesaler, or retailer that manufacturers, knowingly sells, or distributes products in 4 violation of this chapter is subject to a civil penalty not to exceed 5 five thousand dollars for each violation in the case of a first 6 Manufacturers, wholesalers, or retailers who are repeat 7 violators are subject to a civil penalty not to exceed ten thousand 8 9 dollars for each repeat offense. Penalties collected under this section must be deposited in the state toxics control account created 10 11 in RCW 70.105D.070.
- 12 (2) Retailers who unknowingly sell products that are restricted 13 from sale under this chapter are not subject to the civil penalties 14 under this section.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 4. Sections 1 through 3 of this act constitute a new chapter in Title 70 RCW.
