22 for acts of the commission within the scope of the powers conferred  
23 upon it by this chapter;

24 (16) Serve as liaison with the liquor control board on behalf of  
25 the commission and not for any individual producer;

26 (17) Until July 1, 2009, receive such gifts, grants, and endowments  
27 from public or private sources as may be made from time to time, in  
28 trust or otherwise, for the use and benefit of the purposes of the  
29 commission and expend the same or any income therefrom according to the  
30 terms of the gifts, grants, or endowments. Reimbursement shall be made  
31 from the assessments of the commission, and shall not be made by the  
32 department.

35 (1) In the event a position on the commission becomes vacant due to  
36 resignation, disqualification, death, or for any other reason, the

22 branch action.
