- 10 (2) RCW 10.120.020 (Permissible uses of force) and 2021 c 324 s 11 3;
- 12 (3) RCW 10.120.030 (Policies for use of force and de-escalation 13 tactics) and 2021 c 324 s 4;
- 14 (4) RCW 43.101.450 (Violence de-escalation training) and 2021 c
- $324\ s$ 6, $2019\ c$ 1 s 3 (Initiative Measure No. 940), & (2018 c 11 s 3
- 16 (Initiative Measure No. 940) repealed by 2019 c 4 s 8); and
- 17 (5) RCW 43.101.490 (Basic training) and 2021 c 324 s 5.
