- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 39.12 6 RCW to read as follows:
- 7 Distinct prevailing wage rates shall be calculated and paid to
- 8 workers employed in residential construction. "Residential
- 9 construction" means construction alteration, repair improvement, or
- 10 maintenance of single-family dwellings, duplexes, apartments,
- 11 condominiums, and other residential structures not to exceed four
- 12 stories in height, and all incidental items such as site work,
- 13 parking areas, utilities, and streets and sidewalks, pursuant to the
- 14 United States department of labor's "All Agency Memorandum No. 130:
- 15 Application of the Standard of Comparison "Projects of a Character
- 16 Similar" under the Davis-Bacon and Related Acts, dated March 17,
- 17 1978.
