State of Washington 67th Legislature 2022 Regular Session

AN ACT Relating to repealing the statewide 988 behavioral health crisis response and suicide prevention line tax and funding the program through the state general fund; amending RCW 82.86.050; amending 2021 c 302 ss 301, 302, and 303 (uncodified); repealing RCW 82.86.020, 82.86.030, and 82.86.040; making an appropriation; and declaring an emergency.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

8 Sec. 1. RCW 82.86.050 and 2021 c 302 s 205 are each amended to 9 read as follows:

10 (1) The statewide 988 behavioral health crisis response and 11 suicide prevention line account is created in the state treasury. 12 ((All receipts from the statewide 988 behavioral health crisis 13 response and suicide prevention line tax imposed pursuant to this 14 chapter must be deposited into the account)) The account is funded 15 through state general fund appropriations. Moneys may only be spent 16 after appropriation.

17 (2) Expenditures from the account may only be used for (a) 18 ensuring the efficient and effective routing of calls made to the 988 19 crisis hotline to an appropriate crisis hotline center or crisis call 20 center hub; and (b) personnel and the provision of acute behavioral 21 health, crisis outreach, and crisis stabilization services, as 1 defined in RCW 71.24.025, by directly responding to the 988 crisis 2 hotline.

3 (3) Moneys in the account may not be used to supplant general 4 fund appropriations for behavioral health services or for medicaid 5 covered services to individuals enrolled in the medicaid program.

6 Sec. 2. 2021 c 302 s 301 (uncodified) is amended to read as 7 follows:

8 The appropriations in this section are provided to the department 9 of health and are subject to the following conditions and 10 limitations:

11 (1) The sum of \$23,016,000, or as much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for the fiscal biennium ending June 30, 12 2023, from the ((statewide 988 behavioral health crisis response and 13 suicide prevention line account)) state general fund. The amount in 14 15 this subsection is provided solely for the department to route calls 16 to and contract for the operations of call centers and call center hubs. This includes funding for operations, training, and call center 17 18 information technology and program staff.

19 (2) The sum of \$1,000,000, or as much thereof as may be 20 necessary, is appropriated for the fiscal biennium ending June 30, 2023, from the ((statewide 988 behavioral health crisis response and 22 suicide prevention line account)) state general fund. The amount in 23 this subsection is provided solely for the department to contract for 24 the development and operations of a tribal crisis line.

25 (3) The following sums, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are each appropriated: \$189,000 from the ((statewide 988 behavioral 26 27 health crisis response and suicide prevention line account)) state general fund for the fiscal biennium ending June 30, 2023; and 28 \$80,000 from the state general fund-federal account for the fiscal 29 biennium ending June 30, 2023. The amounts in this subsection are 30 31 provided solely for the department to provide staff support necessary to critically analyze the planning, development, and implementation 32 of technology solutions to create the technical and operational plan 33 34 pursuant to section 109 of this act.

35 (4) The sum of \$420,000, or as much thereof as may be necessary, 36 is appropriated for the fiscal biennium ending June 30, 2023, from 37 the ((statewide 988 behavioral health crisis response and suicide 38 prevention line account)) state general fund. The amount in this 39 subsection is provided solely for the department to participate in

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1 and provide support to the committee created in section 103 of this 2 act.

3 Sec. 3. 2021 c 302 s 302 (uncodified) is amended to read as 4 follows:

5 The appropriations in this section are provided to the state 6 health care authority and are subject to the following conditions and 7 limitations:

8 (1) The following sums, or as much thereof as may be necessary, 9 are each appropriated: \$770,000 from the ((statewide 988 behavioral 10 health crisis response and suicide prevention line account)) state 11 general fund for the fiscal biennium ending June 30, 2023; and 12 \$326,000 from the state general fund-federal account for the fiscal biennium ending June 30, 2023. The amounts in this subsection are 13 provided solely for the authority to provide staff and contracted 14 support necessary to critically analyze the planning, development, 15 and implementation of technology solutions to create the technical 16 17 and operational plan pursuant to section 109 of this act.

18 (2) The following sums, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are each appropriated: \$644,000 from the ((statewide 988 behavioral 19 20 health crisis response and suicide prevention line account)) state 21 general fund for the fiscal biennium ending June 30, 2023; and \$127,000 from the state general fund—federal account for the fiscal 22 biennium ending June 30, 2023. The amounts in this subsection are 23 provided solely for the authority to participate in and provide 24 25 support to the committee created in section 103 of this act.

(3) The following sums, or as much thereof as may be necessary, 26 27 are each appropriated: \$381,000 from the ((statewide 988 behavioral 28 health crisis response and suicide prevention line account)) state 29 general fund for the fiscal biennium ending June 30, 2023; and \$381,000 from the state general fund-federal account for the fiscal 30 biennium ending June 30, 2023. The amounts in this subsection are 31 32 provided solely for the authority to fulfill its duties as described 33 in section 102(8) of this act. This includes funding for 34 collaboration with managed care organizations, county authorities, 35 and behavioral health administrative services organizations related 36 to crisis services, and the development of processes and best practices for crisis services. 37

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1 Sec. 4. 2021 c 302 s 303 (uncodified) is amended to read as 2 follows:

The sum of \$200,000, or as much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for the fiscal biennium ending June 30, 2023, from the ((statewide 988 behavioral health crisis response and suicide prevention line account)) state general fund to the office of financial management and provided solely to provide staff and contracted services support to the committee created in section 103 of this act.

10 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 5. The following acts or parts of acts are 11 each repealed:

- 12 (1) RCW 82.86.020 (Tax imposed) and 2021 c 302 s 202;
- 13 (2) RCW 82.86.030 (Collection of tax) and 2021 c 302 s 203; and
- 14 (3) RCW 82.86.040 (Payment and collection) and 2021 c 302 s 204.

15 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 6. This act is necessary for the immediate 16 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of 17 the state government and its existing public institutions, and takes 18 effect immediately.

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
