- AN ACT Relating to ensuring quality ambulance services for medicaid beneficiaries by applying the medicare payment rate for ambulance services furnished under medicaid by providers of ambulance services; adding a new section to chapter 74.09 RCW; and creating a new section.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 7 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The legislature finds as follows:
- 8 (1) Quality ambulance services are essential to ensuring quality 9 of life for Washingtonians.
- 10 (2) A recent Washington state health care authority study found 11 that current medicaid reimbursement is between sixteen and twenty-12 eight percent of what other payers reimburse for equivalent services 13 and is substantially below the level needed to cover the costs of 14 service. The previous study resulting in a fee increase specifically 15 for ambulance services occurred in 2004.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 74.09
 RCW to read as follows:
- Medicaid payment for ambulance services furnished by state licensed ambulance services, must be at a rate not less than one

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- 1 hundred percent of the payment rate that applies to those services
- 2 and providers under medicare.

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
