## SENATE BILL 5984

State of Washington 63rd Legislature 2014 Regular Session

1 AN ACT Relating to banning certain flame retardants in children's 2 products and residential upholstered furniture; amending RCW 3 70.240.050; and adding a new section to chapter 70.240 RCW.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 70.240 RCW 6 to read as follows:

7 Beginning July 1, 2015, no manufacturer, wholesaler, or retailer may manufacture, knowingly sell, offer for sale, distribute for sale, 8 or distribute for use in this state children's products or residential 9 10 upholstered furniture, as defined in RCW 70.76.010, containing TDCPP (tris(1,3-dichloro-2-propyl)phosphate), chemical abstracts service 11 number 13674-87-8, as of the effective date of this section, or TCEP 12 13 (tris(2-chloroethyl)phosphate), chemical abstracts service number 115-96-8, as of the effective date of this section, in amounts greater than 14 15 one hundred parts per million in any product component.

16 Sec. 2. RCW 70.240.050 and 2008 c 288 s 7 are each amended to read 17 as follows:

18 (1) A manufacturer of products that are restricted under this

chapter must notify persons that sell the manufacturer's products in
 this state about the provisions of this chapter no less than ninety
 days prior to the effective date of the restrictions.

4 (2) A manufacturer that produces, sells, or distributes a product
5 prohibited from manufacture, sale, or distribution in this state under
6 this chapter shall recall the product and reimburse the retailer or any
7 other purchaser for the product.

8 (3) A manufacturer of children's products in violation of this 9 chapter is subject to a civil penalty not to exceed five thousand 10 dollars for each violation in the case of a first offense. 11 Manufacturers who are repeat violators are subject to a civil penalty 12 not to exceed ten thousand dollars for each repeat offense. Penalties 13 collected under this section must be deposited in the state toxics 14 control account created in RCW 70.105D.070.

15 (4) Retailers who unknowingly sell products that are restricted 16 from sale under this chapter are not liable under this chapter.

17 (5) The sale or purchase of any previously owned product containing 18 a chemical restricted under this chapter made in casual or isolated 19 sales as defined in RCW 82.04.040, or by a nonprofit organization, is 20 exempt from this chapter.

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
