1 AN ACT Relating to election of public hospital district boards of
2 commissioners; amending RCW 70.44.040 and 70.44.054; and adding a new
3 section to chapter 70.44 RCW.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 70.44.040 and 2006 c 322 s 1 are each amended to read
6 as follows:

7 (1) The provisions of Title 29A RCW relating to elections (~~shall~~)
8 govern public hospital (~~districts~~) district elections, except as
9 provided in this chapter.

10 (2) A public hospital district shall be created when the ballot
11 proposition authorizing the creation of the district is approved by a
12 simple majority vote of the voters of the proposed district voting on
13 the proposition and the total vote cast upon the proposition exceeds
14 forty percent of the total number of votes cast in the proposed
15 district at the preceding state general election.

16 (3)(a) A public hospital district initially may be created with
17 three, five, or seven commissioner districts.

18 (b) At the election at which the proposition is submitted to the
19 voters as to whether a district shall be formed, three, five, or seven

1 commissioners shall be elected from either three, five, or seven
2 commissioner districts, or at-large positions, or both, as determined
3 by resolution of the county commissioners of the county or counties in
4 which the proposed public hospital district is located, ~~((all))~~ in
5 accordance with RCW 70.44.054. The election of the initial
6 commissioners ~~((shall be))~~ is null and void if the district is not
7 authorized ~~((to be created))~~ as provided in subsection (2) of this
8 section.

9 (c) No primary ~~((shall be))~~ is held. A special filing period
10 ~~((shall))~~ must be opened as provided in RCW 29A.24.171 and 29A.24.181.
11 The person receiving the greatest number of votes for ~~((the))~~
12 commissioner of each commissioner district or at-large position ~~((shall~~
13 ~~be))~~ is elected as the commissioner of that district or at-large
14 position.

15 (d) The terms of office of the initial public hospital district
16 commissioners ~~((shall))~~ must be staggered, with the length of the terms
17 assigned so that the person or persons who are elected receiving the
18 greater number of votes ~~((being))~~ are assigned a longer term or terms
19 of office ~~((and)).~~ Each term of an initial commissioner ((running))
20 runs until a successor assumes office who is elected at one of the next
21 three following district general elections the first of which occurs at
22 least one hundred twenty days after the date of the election where
23 voters approved the ballot proposition creating the district~~((7)).~~
24 Elections occur as follows:

25 ~~((a))~~ (i) If the public hospital district will have three
26 commissioners, the successor to one initial commissioner ~~((shall))~~ must
27 be elected at ~~((such))~~ the first following district general election,
28 the successor to one initial commissioner ~~((shall))~~ must be elected at
29 the second following district general election, and the successor to
30 one initial commissioner ~~((shall))~~ must be elected at the third
31 following district general election;

32 ~~((b))~~ (ii) If the public hospital district will have five
33 commissioners, the successor to one initial commissioner ~~((shall))~~ must
34 be elected at ~~((such))~~ the first following district general election,
35 the successors to two initial commissioners ~~((shall))~~ must be elected
36 at the second following district general election, and the successors
37 to two initial commissioners ~~((shall))~~ must be elected at the third
38 following district general election;

1 (~~(e)~~) (iii) If the public hospital district will have seven
2 commissioners, the successors to two initial commissioners (~~(shall)~~)
3 must be elected at (~~(such)~~) the first following district general
4 election, the successors to two initial commissioners (~~(shall)~~) must be
5 elected at the second following district general election, and the
6 successors to three initial commissioners (~~(shall)~~) must be elected at
7 the third following district general election.

8 (e) The initial commissioners (~~(shall)~~) must take office
9 immediately when they are elected and qualified. The term of office of
10 each successor (~~(shall be)~~) is six years. Each commissioner (~~(shall)~~)
11 serves until a successor is elected and qualified and assumes office in
12 accordance with RCW 29A.20.040.

13 (~~(2)~~) (4) Only a registered voter who resides in a commissioner
14 district may be a candidate for, or hold office as, a commissioner
15 (~~(of)~~) representing the commissioner district. Voters of the entire
16 public hospital district may vote at a primary or general election to
17 elect a person as a commissioner (~~(of the)~~) representing a commissioner
18 district, or to elect a person as an at-large commissioner, unless the
19 public hospital district must establish the election system specified
20 in section 3 of this act.

21 (5) If the proposed public hospital district initially will have
22 three commissioner districts and the public hospital district is
23 countywide, and if the county has three county legislative authority
24 districts, the county legislative authority districts (~~(shall)~~) must be
25 used as public hospital district commissioner districts. In all other
26 instances, the county auditor of the county in which all or the largest
27 portion of the proposed public hospital district is located (~~(shall)~~)
28 must draw the initial public hospital district commissioner districts
29 and designate at-large positions, if appropriate, as provided in RCW
30 70.44.054. Each of the commissioner positions (~~(shall)~~) must be
31 numbered consecutively and associated with the commissioner district or
32 at-large position of the same number.

33 (6) The commissioners of a public hospital district that is not
34 coterminous with the boundaries of a county that has three county
35 legislative authority districts (~~(shall)~~) must at the times required in
36 chapter 29A.76 RCW and may from time to time redraw commissioner
37 district boundaries in a manner consistent with chapter 29A.76 RCW.

1 (~~(3)~~) (7) No person may hold office as a commissioner while
2 serving as an employee of the public hospital district.

3 **Sec. 2.** RCW 70.44.054 and 1997 c 99 s 4 are each amended to read
4 as follows:

5 (1) In accordance with RCW 70.44.040, only a registered voter who
6 resides in a commissioner district of a public hospital district may be
7 a candidate for, or hold office as, a commissioner representing the
8 commissioner district. Voters of the entire public hospital district
9 may vote at a primary or general election to elect a person as a
10 commissioner representing a commissioner district, or to elect a person
11 as an at-large commissioner, unless the public hospital district must
12 establish the election system specified in section 3 of this act.

13 (2) If the voters of (~~the~~) a public hospital district approve
14 (~~the~~) a ballot proposition authorizing (~~the~~) an increase in the
15 number of commissioners to either five or seven members, the additional
16 commissioners (~~shall~~) must be elected at large from the entire public
17 hospital district(~~;~~ ~~provided that~~)). However, the board of
18 commissioners of the public hospital district may, by resolution,
19 redistrict the public hospital district into five commissioner
20 districts if the district has five commissioners, or seven commissioner
21 districts if the district has seven commissioners. The board of
22 commissioners (~~shall~~) must draw the boundaries of each commissioner
23 district to include as nearly as possible equal portions of the total
24 population of the public hospital district.

25 If the board of commissioners increases the number of commissioner
26 districts as provided in this section, one commissioner (~~shall~~) must
27 be elected from each commissioner district, and no commissioner may be
28 elected from a commissioner district in which another commissioner
29 resides.

30 NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. A new section is added to chapter 70.44 RCW
31 to read as follows:

32 (1) The board of commissioners of a public hospital district with
33 a population exceeding two hundred ninety thousand persons must:

34 (a) Establish commissioner districts within the public hospital
35 district that conform with criteria specified in RCW 29A.76.010; and

1 (b) Provide that each member of the board of commissioners will be
2 nominated in a primary and elected in a general election solely by
3 voters in the member's commissioner district, rather than by voters in
4 the entire public hospital district.

5 (2) A resolution adopted pursuant to subsection (1) of this section
6 may not reduce the term of a commissioner serving in office at the time
7 that the resolution is adopted. Subsequently, elected commissioners
8 must be elected from the commissioner districts in which they reside.
9 One commissioner must be elected from each commissioner district, and
10 no commissioner may be elected from a commissioner district in which
11 another commissioner resides.

12 (3) A public hospital district must comply with subsection (1) of
13 this section within eight months of the effective date of this section
14 if the district's population estimate exceeds two hundred ninety
15 thousand persons as of the effective date of this section.

16 (4) A public hospital district with a population estimate below two
17 hundred ninety thousand persons as of the effective date of this
18 section must comply with subsection (1) of this section by June 1st of
19 the year following release of a population estimate indicating that the
20 district's population has risen to exceed two hundred ninety thousand
21 persons.

22 (5) For purposes of this section, "population estimate" means a
23 population estimate annually compiled for each public hospital district
24 in the state by the office of financial management and posted annually
25 by October 1st on the office's web site.

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
