1 AN ACT Relating to fentanyl; amending RCW 9A.42.100; and 2 prescribing penalties.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 Sec. 1. RCW 9A.42.100 and 2005 c 218 s 4 are each amended to 5 read as follows:

6 <u>(1)</u> A person is guilty of the crime of endangerment with a 7 controlled substance if the person knowingly or intentionally permits 8 a dependent child or dependent adult to be exposed to, ingest, 9 inhale, or have contact with:

10 <u>(a) Methamphetamine or ephedrine, pseudoephedrine, or anhydrous</u> 11 ammonia, including their salts, isomers, and salts of isomers, that 12 are being used in the manufacture of methamphetamine, including its 13 salts, isomers, and salts of isomers<u>; or</u>

(b) Fentanyl, including its salts, isomers, and salts of isomers,
that are being used in the manufacture of fentanyl, including its
salts, isomers, and salts of isomers.

17 (2) Endangerment with a controlled substance does not include 18 exposure, ingestion, inhalation, or contact with a controlled 19 substance as administered pursuant to a prescription for a dependent 20 child or dependent adult as outlined in chapter 69.50 RCW. --- END ---
