- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- Sec. 1. (1) The department of children, youth, and 5 NEW SECTION. 6 families, in consultation with the department of early learning, the office of the superintendent of public instruction, the office of 7 financial management, the caseload forecast council, legislative 8 9 fiscal staff, and with advice and assistance from the applicable 10 committees of the state interagency coordinating council, 11 develop a funding model with which to determine the amount of annual allocations that shall be appropriated in the omnibus appropriations 12 act after July 1, 2019, for early intervention services for children 13 14 with disabilities from birth through two years of age, which the department of children, youth, and families oversees. 15
- 16 (2) The department must submit a final report that includes the 17 agreed-upon funding model and any necessary statutory changes to the 18 office of financial management and the fiscal committees of the 19 legislature no later than September 1, 2018.

- 1 (3) This section expires July 1, 2020.
