- 2 fees and fee distributions; amending RCW 46.17.005, 46.17.040, and
- 3 46.68.400; and providing an effective date.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 46.17.005 and 2010 c 161 s 501 are each amended to 6 read as follows:
- 7 (1) A person who applies for a vehicle registration or for any 8 other right to operate a vehicle on the highways of this state shall 9 pay a ((three)) four dollar and fifty cent filing fee in addition to
- 10 any other fees and taxes required by law.
- 11 (2) A person who applies for a certificate of title shall pay a
- 12 ((four)) <u>five</u> dollar <u>and fifty cent</u> filing fee in addition to any
- 13 other fees and taxes required by law.
- 14 (3) The filing fees established in this section must be
- distributed under RCW 46.68.400.
- 16 **Sec. 2.** RCW 46.17.040 and 2014 c 59 s 2 are each amended to read 17 as follows:
- 18 (1) The department, county auditor or other agent, or subagent
- 19 appointed by the director shall collect a service fee of:

1 (a) ((Twelve)) <u>Eighteen</u> dollars for changes in a certificate of 2 title, with or without registration renewal, or for verification of 3 record and preparation of an affidavit of lost title other than at 4 the time of the certificate of title application or transfer; and

- (b) ((Five)) Nine dollars for a registration renewal, issuing a transit permit, or any other service under this section.
- 7 (2) Service fees collected under this section by the department 8 or county auditor or other agent appointed by the director must be 9 credited to the capital vessel replacement account under RCW 10 47.60.322.
- 11 **Sec. 3.** RCW 46.68.400 and 2010 c 161 s 819 are each amended to 12 read as follows:
- 13 A filing fee established in RCW 46.17.005 must be distributed as 14 follows:
 - (1) If paid to the county auditor or other agent or subagent appointed by the director, the fee must be distributed to the county treasurer and credited to the county current expense fund except that fifty cents of the fee must be distributed at least quarterly by the department to each county in the state equally.
- 20 (2) If the fee is paid to another agent of the director, the fee 21 must be used by the agent to defray his or her expenses in handling 22 the application.
 - (3) If the fee is collected by the state patrol as agent for the director, the fee must be certified to the state treasurer and deposited to the credit of the state patrol highway account.
 - (4) If the fee is collected by the department of transportation as agent for the director, the fee must be certified to the state treasurer and deposited to the credit of the motor vehicle fund created in RCW 46.68.070.
- 30 (5) If the fee is collected by the director or branches of the department, the fee must be certified to the state treasurer and 31 deposited to the credit of the highway safety fund, except that two 32 deposited 33 dollars of the fee must be into the multimodal transportation account if the fee is collected in conjunction with 34 35 RCW 46.17.350(1) (c) or (k) or 46.17.355.
