1 AN ACT Relating to wildlife damage claim assessment costs; and 2 amending RCW 77.36.120.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 77.36.120 and 2009 c 333 s 57 are each amended to 5 read as follows:

6 The department shall establish:

7 (1) The form of affidavits or proof required to accompany all8 claims under this chapter;

9 (2) The process, time, and methods used to identify and assess 10 damage, including the anticipated timeline for the initiation and 11 conclusion of department action;

12 (3) How claims will be prioritized when available funds for 13 reimbursement are limited;

14 (4) Timelines after the discovery of damage by which an owner15 must file a claim or notify the department;

16 (5) Protocols for an owner to follow if the owner wishes to 17 undertake activities that would complicate the determination of 18 damages, such as harvesting damaged crops;

(6) The process for determining damage assessments, including the
role and selection of professional damage assessors ((and)). The

1 <u>department has</u> the responsibility ((for)) to pay the full cost of 2 reimbursing third-party assessors for their services;

3 (7) Timelines for a claimant to accept, reject, or appeal a 4 determination made by the department;

5 (8) The identification of instances when an owner would be 6 ineligible for compensation;

7 (9) An appeals process for an owner eligible for compensation 8 under RCW 77.36.100 who is denied a claim or feels the compensation 9 is insufficient; and

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(10) Other policies necessary for administering this chapter.

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
