- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** (1)(a) The superintendent of public
- 5 instruction, collaboratively with the state board of education shall
- 6 establish a working group to examine the changes and challenges that
- 7 are impacting student learning in mathematics and science, and develop
- 8 recommendations and a plan to make significant improvement in student
- 9 learning in these content areas, especially at the high school level.
- 10 The working group shall examine the capacity of the educational system
- 11 to address the challenges listed in section 1 of this act, and the

- 1 (iv) How to ensure that students will have an opportunity to learn 2 the mathematics and science that will be assessed; and
  - (v) Other areas deemed relevant by the state board of education.
  - (b) The superintendent of public instruction, with the state board of education shall submit a report to the education committees of the legislature by November 30, 2010. The report shall contain findings from the examination of the issues under this section, recommendations for changes, and a timeline for expedited implementation of the recommended changes.
    - (2) This section expires September 30, 2011.
