**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,
TO SENATE BILL 371**

December 27, 2023 - Offered by Representative KURTZ.

AUTHORS SUBJECT TO CHANGE

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 2, line 5: delete the material beginning with that line and ending with
3 line 6 and substitute:

4 “(qs) Grant program for incumbent

5 local exchange carriers SEG B -0- 6,000,000”.

6 **2.** Page 2, line 10: after “(bx).” insert “No moneys may be encumbered under
7 this paragraph after June 30, 2027.”.

8 **3.** Page 3, line 9: after that line insert:

9 “**SECTION 4. Nonstatutory provisions.**

10 (1) The department of military affairs shall, by January 1, 2027, submit to the
11 chief clerk of each house of the legislature for distribution to the legislature under
12 s. 13.172 (2), a report that includes all of the following:

1 (a) A summary of the status of the emergency services IP network required
2 under s. 256.35 (3s) (b).

3 (b) A summary of the total amount of grants issued under s. 256.35 (3s) (bx) 2.
4 for each of the following purposes in each fiscal year that the grant program under
5 s. 256.35 (3s) (bx) has operated:

6 1. Reimbursement of incumbent local exchange carriers' costs associated with
7 the IP-based transport of Next Generation 911.

8 2. Reimbursement of incumbent local exchange carriers' costs associated with
9 the database used to operate Next Generation 911.

10 3. Reimbursement of incumbent local exchange carriers' costs associated with
11 the purchase, installation, and maintenance of Next Generation 911 equipment.

12 (c) A projection for additional necessary costs for reimbursement of incumbent
13 local exchange carriers' costs in the future.

14 (d) A recommendation as to whether the grant program under s. s. 256.35 (3s)
15 (bx) should continue to operate after June 30, 2027.”.
