## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Current law limits the compensation of the Wisconsin Housing and Economic Development Authority (WHEDA) staff and executive director to the maximum salary range for executive salary group 6. Under Senate Bill 1024 (SB1024), the maximum is raised to 126.8 percent of the maximum salary range for executive salary group 6.

WHEDA does not receive General Purpose Revenue (GPR) from the State of Wisconsin to cover the administration of the organization, including salary for the executive director or any other staff. These costs are paid for by program revenue generated by WHEDA's existing programs.

The maximum salary range was applied to WHEDA in 1983. Since 1983, WHEDA has grown from a \$800 million organization being primarily focused on multifamily housing to a \$3 billion organization with diverse housing and economic development programs, the management of federal and state resources, and more than 180 employees.

Raising the maximum salary range for executive salary group 6 will not have a fiscal effect on the state.
