Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This legislation extends several Coronavirus pandemic policy provisions affecting the insurance industry that were enacted in 2019 Wisconsin Act 185 including:

- · Liability insurance for physicians and nurse anesthetists
- Out-of-network costs related to health coverage
- · Coverage of COVID-19 testing and vaccination without cost-sharing
- Coverage limits on certain prescription drugs

This legislation extends these specific Coronavirus policy provisions.

Additionally, this legislation would require coverage and testing of COVID-19 or any other communicable disease for frontline health care workers infected or under investigation of having COVID-19 or any other communicable disease without imposing a copayment or coinsurance. Also, this legislation prohibits a health insurer from denying coverage for a treatment or service provided through telehealth if the treatment or service is covered under the policy or plan when provided in person by a health care provider.

Due to uncertainty around the length of the public health emergency, this bill's fiscal impact on the Office of the Commissioner of Insurance is indeterminate at this time.
