Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This fiscal estimate is submitted by the Director of the State Prosecutors Office on behalf of Agency 475 - district Attorneys. This fiscal estimate is responsive only to the fiscal and resource effect of the proposed legislation on the District Attorney Program.

The fiscal impact of the bill on the individual district attorney offices is indeterminate. Although it is unknown how many kratom cases are currently brought, the removal of kratom from the schedule of controlled substances would likely mean the potential for fewer kratom-related cases.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

The long-range fiscal implications of this bill are unknown.
