Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill creates a \$250 nonrefundable income tax credit for persons who have been granted deferred action under the Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) program of the U.S. Department of Homeland Security.

According to the Department of Homeland Security, U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services, Office of Performance and Quality, there were approximately 5,830 active DACA recipients in Wisconsin as of December 31, 2022. If all eligible individuals claimed the credit under this bill, it would result in a revenue loss of as much as \$1.46 million annually, beginning in fiscal year 2025.

Because the credit is limited by the claimant's tax liability, the revenue reduction will be less than the total credit amount. To the extent that eligible individuals do not claim the credit, the revenue effect will also be smaller.

According to the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Net Tax Reduction Calculation Update memo released by the Department of Administration on 8/28/2023, the remaining margin for tax reductions before triggering potential SLFRF recoupment at \$113 million for fiscal year 2024 and \$319 million for fiscal year 2025. This bill would reduce these margins by the amount of fiscal effect.
