Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Under this bill, the Department of Public Instruction must provide stipends to individuals who are 1) enrolled in an undergraduate or graduate program leading to licensure as a school social worker and 2) placed as a school social worker intern in a public school governed by a school board.

The bill creates a new \$2 million annual GPR appropriation beginning in FY24 to provide the intern stipends to eligible individuals.

State: Increase state costs by \$2 million annually beginning in FY24.

Since the bill does not provide funding to the department to create and administer the program, the department would need to reallocate existing resources to cover those added costs.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications
