Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill creates a council on child care availability, to be housed in the Department of Children and Families. Under the bill, DCF is required to create a biennial report detailing the actual cost of child care, broken out by the type of care provided and compared to the child care rates established by DCF under current law.

The fiscal impact is indeterminate, with possible costs coming from time spent by council members and potential data analysis costs in compiling the required report.

The council itself would be attended by the Secretaries of DCF and DWD or their designees, which would require time allocation. The report would require detailed data gathering and analysis, which would likely require staff time at DCF.
