## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Under current law, school districts must ensure that every teacher, supervisor, administrator, and professional staff member holds a certificate, license, or permit to teach issued by DPI before beginning such a position.

Under current law, DPI is also responsible for licensing related to public library personnel.

This bill would provide an additional \$1,000,000 in fiscal year 2023-24 to pay for and authorize an additional 10.0 FTE GPR positions for licensing school and public library personnel.

State fiscal impact: Increase revenues, increase costs

This bill would increase the existing GPR 20.255 (1) (a) appropriation by \$1,000,000. This would cover the costs of the authorized 10.0 FTE GPR positions.

Local impact: No direct impact

This has no direct impact on local fiscal operations.

## Long-Range Fiscal Implications

This would increase the 20.255 (1) (a) appropriation to fund ongoing position costs beginning in fiscal year 2023-24.
