Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Under current law, the Department of Health Services awards grants to several classes of community health centers. This bill increases funding for this grant program by \$2,500,000 GPR annually. In addition, if the grants are awarded, the bill provides additional funding to the Department of Public Instruction for aids for special education and to the University of Wisconsin System and the technical college system. This bill continues the allocation of grants in 2019 Wisconsin Act 9 that requires DHS to give \$500,000 GPR in grants annually. To satisfy the activities of the proposed legislation, DHS will not require additional resources. In sum, the total fiscal effect of the bill is \$2,500,000 GPR annually.
