2017 ASSEMBLY BILL 170

2 and 86.191 (6) (d) 6. of the statutes; **relating to:** advertising on bus shelters
3 located on state trunk highways.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under this bill, advertising signs may be placed on bus shelters located on state trunk highways. Current law prohibits placing advertising signs within a highway right-of-way, subject to certain exceptions. This bill creates another exception for signs placed on bus shelters located on state trunk highways, subject to limitations.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

7 1. “Business entity” has the meaning given in s. 13.62 (5), but does not include
8 any real estate broker or salesperson licensed under ch. 452 or any other individual
9 selling real estate or personal property owned by the individual.
