commissioners to issue search warrants for certain civil violations.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill authorizes court commissioners to issue search warrants in matters involving a civil violation of a state or local prohibition against driving while having a prohibited alcohol concentration or while under the influence of an intoxicant, a controlled substance, a controlled substance analog, or any combination of an intoxicant, a controlled substance, and a controlled substance analog.

Under current law, court commissioners may authorize search warrants in criminal matters.
