2021 ASSEMBLY BILL 25

1 AN ACT *to create* 103.375 of the statutes; **relating to:** prohibiting mandatory
2 vaccination for employment.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Prohibiting vaccination against SARS-CoV-2 as condition of employment

This bill prohibits an employer from requiring an individual to receive a vaccine against the SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus or show evidence of having received such a vaccine.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 SECTION 1. 103.375 of the statutes is created to read:
4 **103.375 Mandatory vaccination for employment prohibited.** No
5 employer may require an employee or prospective employee to receive a vaccine
6 against the SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus, which causes COVID-19, or show proof of
7 having received such a vaccine, as a condition of an offer of employment or continued
8 employment with the employer.
