2011 ASSEMBLY BILL 258

September 15, 2011 - Introduced by Representatives E. Coggs and Young. Referred to Committee on Criminal Justice and Corrections.

AN ACT relating to: requiring the Department of Corrections to increase participation in work release and treatment programs.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires the Department of Corrections to increase by 200 in each year of the 2011–13 fiscal biennium, in a county having a population of 750,000 or more, the number of participants in its work release program and the number of participants in its treatment–based earned release program.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Nonstatutory provisions.

(1) Work Release; increases. The department of corrections shall increase, in a county having a population of 750,000 or more, the number of participants in a work release program under section 303.065 of the statutes by 200 in fiscal year 2011–12 and by 200 in fiscal year 2012–13.
