## 2021 ASSEMBLY BILL 276

April 16, 2021 - Introduced by Representatives Cabral-Guevara, Bowen, Edming, Knodl, Magnafici, Schraa, Sortwell, Tranel, Wichgers and Sinicki, cosponsored by Senators Roth, Ballweg and Feyen. Referred to Committee on State Affairs.

- 1 AN ACT to amend 97.30 (5) of the statutes; relating to: allowing dogs on the
- 2 premises of certain retail food establishments.

#### Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill prohibits the Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection from promulgating a rule that prohibits dogs from the premises of a retail food establishment that receives not more than 5 percent of its total revenues from the sale of food. Under current law, DATCP has authority to promulgate rules governing the operation of retail food establishments.

# The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **SECTION 1.** 97.30 (5) of the statutes is amended to read:
- 4 97.30 (5) RULE MAKING. The department may promulgate rules to establish the
- 5 fees required under sub. (3) or to govern the operation of retail food establishments.
- Rules may include standards for the construction and maintenance of facilities; the
- design, installation, cleaning and maintenance of equipment and utensils; personnel
- 8 sanitation; food handling, display and storage; and food sources and food labeling.
