



2021 ASSEMBLY BILL 311

May 4, 2021 - Introduced by Representatives ROZAR, ALLEN, ARMSTRONG, BOWEN, DRAKE, EDMING, JAMES, KITCHENS, MAGNAFICI, MURPHY, MURSAU, SINICKI, SPREITZER and VRUWINK, cosponsored by Senators BERNIER, BRADLEY and L. TAYLOR. Referred to Committee on Local Government.

AUTHORS SUBJECT TO CHANGE

1 **AN ACT to amend** 1.10 (4); and **to create** 1.10 (3) (w) of the statutes; **relating**
2 **to:** designating Colby as the state cheese.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill designates Colby as the state cheese and requires the Wisconsin Blue Book to include information concerning that designation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 1.10 (3) (w) of the statutes is created to read:

4 1.10 (3) (w) Colby is the state cheese.

5 **SECTION 2.** 1.10 (4) of the statutes is amended to read:

6 1.10 (4) The Wisconsin Blue Book shall include the information contained in
7 this section concerning the state song, ballad, waltz, dance, beverage, tree, grain,
8 flower, bird, fish, animal, domestic animal, wildlife animal, dog, insect, fossil,
9 mineral, rock, soil, fruit, tartan, pastry, dairy product, and herb, and cheese.
