



2017 ASSEMBLY BILL 328

May 16, 2017 - Introduced by Representatives MILROY, KLEEFISCH, CONSIDINE, CROWLEY, GANNON, HESSELBEIN, HORLACHER, KREMER, KRUG, KULP, MASON, MURSAU, QUINN, RIPP, STEFFEN, TITTL and TUSLER, cosponsored by Senators MOULTON, MILLER, COWLES, CRAIG, HARS DORF, RINGHAND, L. TAYLOR and VINEHOUT. Referred to Committee on Natural Resources and Sporting Heritage.

AUTHORS SUBJECT TO CHANGE

1 **AN ACT** *to create* 29.014 (1s) of the statutes; **relating to:** a uniform end date for
2 certain open hunting and trapping seasons.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires the Department of Natural Resources to establish a uniform end date for open hunting and trapping seasons for pheasant, gray partridge, and fisher, for wild turkey hunting in the fall, and for deer hunted only by archers. The bill requires the open season for each to end on the Sunday nearest January 6.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 29.014 (1s) of the statutes is created to read:

4 29.014 (1s) If the department establishes an open season for hunting or
5 trapping any of the following animals, the department shall end the open season for
6 each on the Sunday nearest January 6:

7 (a) Pheasant.
