2023 ASSEMBLY BILL 405

September 6, 2023 - Introduced by Representatives MICHALSKI, MAXEY, VINING and DITTRICH, cosponsored by Senator HUTTON. Referred to Joint Committee on Finance.

AUTHORS SUBJECT TO CHANGE

1 **AN ACT relating to:** grant to The Ability Center for a project to convert a park
2 in southeast Wisconsin for the provision of recreation and rehabilitation
3 opportunities for individuals with disabilities and making an appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires the Department of Administration to award a grant in the amount of \$3,000,000 to A.F.A.R., Inc., doing business as The Ability Center, to assist The Ability Center to convert an existing park in southeast Wisconsin for the provision of recreation and rehabilitation opportunities for individuals with disabilities.
