2017 ASSEMBLY BILL 458

- 1 AN ACT to amend 753.06 (4) (a) of the statutes; relating to: adding a circuit court
- 2 branch in Calumet County.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill adds one circuit court branch for Calumet County, effective August 1, 2018.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **SECTION 1.** 753.06 (4) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:
- 4 753.06 (4) (a) Calumet County. The circuit has one branch. <u>Commencing on</u>
- 5 <u>August 1, 2018, the circuit has 2 branches.</u>
- 6 SECTION 2. Nonstatutory provisions.
- 7 (1) The first election for circuit judge for branch 2 of the circuit court for
- 8 Calumet County shall be at the 2018 spring election for a term commencing on
- 9 August 1, 2018.

1	(2) The authorized FTE positions for the circuit courts, funded from the
2	appropriation under section 20.625 (1) (a) of the statutes, are increased by 1.0 GPR
3	circuit court judge position on August 1, 2018, for the purpose of providing one circuit
4	court judge for the circuit court branch created by this act in Calumet County.

5 (3) The authorized FTE positions for the circuit courts, funded from the 6 appropriation under section 20.625 (1) (a) of the statutes, are increased by 1.0 GPR 7 court reporter position on August 1, 2018, for the purpose of providing one court 8 reporter for the circuit court branch created by this act in Calumet County.
