## 2013 ASSEMBLY BILL 503

November 12, 2013 – Introduced by Representatives Knudson, Kooyenga, Krug, Murphy, Tittl, Ohnstad, Knodl and Murtha, cosponsored by Senators Harsdorf, L. Taylor, Grothman and Tiffany. Referred to Committee on State Affairs and Government Operations.

1	$AN\ ACT$ to amend $440.62\ (3)\ (ar)\ 2.,\ 454.02\ (3)\ (b)$ and $454.06\ (2)\ (b)$ ; and to create
2	454.02 (3) (bm) and 454.21 (3) of the statutes; relating to: cosmetologist
3	training hours and exemption of makeup artists from barbering and
4	cosmetology licensure requirements.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, an applicant for a cosmetologist license must complete at least 1,800 training hours in a course of instruction in cosmetology. This bill changes the required number of training hours to 1,550.

Also under current law, a person must be licensed in order to perform barbering, cosmetology, aesthetics, or manicuring for compensation in this state. This bill exempts the following services from those licensure requirements:

- 1. A service performed preparatory to a live public performance or appearance, whether in–person or through broadcast media.
- 2. A service performed in the course of the production of any digital, analog, or other recording of a moving or still image intended for public release or broadcast.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

## **ASSEMBLY BILL 503**

<b>Section 1.</b> 440.62 (3) (ar) 2. of the statutes is amended to read:
440.62 (3) (ar) 2. Requires as a prerequisite to graduation completion of a
course of instruction in cosmetology of at least $\frac{1,800}{1,550}$ training hours in not less
than 10 months. The course of instruction may not exceed 8 training hours in any
one day for any student or 48 hours in any one week for any student.
<b>Section 2.</b> 454.02 (3) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:
454.02 (3) (b) Applying cosmetics A service performed preparatory to a live
public performance or appearance, whether in-person or through broadcast media,
including the Internet.
<b>Section 3.</b> 454.02 (3) (bm) of the statutes is created to read:
454.02 (3) (bm) A service performed in the course of the production of any
digital, analog, or other recording of a moving or still image intended for public
release or broadcast, including through the Internet.
<b>Section 4.</b> 454.06 (2) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:
454.06 (2) (b) Graduates from a course of instruction of at least $\frac{1,800}{1,550}$
training hours in not less than 10 months in a school of cosmetology licensed under
s. 440.62 (3) (ar) or exempted under s. 440.61 or has successfully completed an
apprenticeship under s. 454.10.
<b>Section 5.</b> 454.21 (3) of the statutes is created to read:
454.21 (3) (a) A service performed preparatory to a live public performance or
appearance, whether in-person or through broadcast media, including the Internet.
(b) A service performed in the course of the production of any digital or analog
recording of a moving or still image intended for public release or broadcast,
including through the Internet.
