1 **AN ACT** *to renumber and amend* 15.06 (5) of the statutes; **relating to:**
2 relocating the offices of the Elections Commission.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law requires that every commission maintain its offices in the city of Madison. Under this bill, beginning no later than April 15, 2024, the Elections Commission must maintain its offices in the city of Wausau.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 15.06 (5) of the statutes is renumbered 15.06 (5) (a) and amended
4 to read:

5 15.06 (5) (a) Every commission shall meet on the call of the chairperson or a
6 majority of its members. ~~Every~~ Except as provided in par. (b), every commission shall
7 maintain its offices in Madison, but may meet or hold hearings at such other
8 locations as will best serve the citizens of this state.
