2015 ASSEMBLY BILL 555

December 1, 2015 – Introduced by Representatives Sargent, Subeck, Johnson, Pope, Brostoff, Young, Hebl, Sinicki, Stuck and Bowen, cosponsored by Senators Risser and L. Taylor. Referred to Committee on State Affairs and Government Operations.

- 3 of feminine hygiene products in state buildings and school buildings.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires that women's restroom facilities in buildings owned, leased, or occupied by the state have available tampons and sanitary napkins at no charge. The bill also requires each school district, operator of an independent charter school, and governing body of a private school participating in a parental choice program to make available tampons and sanitary napkins at no charge in women's restroom facilities in buildings owned, leased, or occupied by the school board, operator, or governing body.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. 16.84 (5m) of the statutes is created to read:

A requirement that the charter school governing board make tampons and sanitary napkins available at no charge in all of the women's restroom facilities in any building in which direct instruction is provided to pupils enrolled in the charter school that is owned, leased, or occupied by the charter school governing board for the operation of the charter school.

Section 4. 118.60 (6m) (e) of the statutes is created to read:

118.60 **(6m)** (e) Make tampons and sanitary napkins available at no charge in all of the women's restroom facilities in any building in which direct instruction is provided to pupils enrolled in the private school that is owned, leased, or occupied by the governing body of the private school.

Section 5. 119.23 (6m) (e) of the statutes is created to read:

119.23 **(6m)** (e) Make tampons and sanitary napkins available at no charge in all of the women's restroom facilities in any building in which direct instruction is provided to pupils enrolled in the private school that is owned, leased, or occupied by the governing body of the private school.
