## 2023 ASSEMBLY BILL 598

1     **AN ACT to create** 13.45 (8) of the statutes; **relating to:** requiring a public hearing  
2           on bills with several cosponsors.

*Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

This bill requires that a bill referred to committee receive a public hearing no later than 90 days after its referral if at least one-third of the members of either house of the legislature have signed on as cosponsors of the bill.

---

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

3           **SECTION 1.** 13.45 (8) of the statutes is created to read:  
4           13.45 (8) PUBLIC HEARINGS; COSPONSORS. Any bill referred to a legislative  
5           committee that has not received a public hearing shall be scheduled for a public  
6           hearing no later than 90 days after its referral if at least one-third of the members  
7           of either house of the legislature have signed on as cosponsors of the bill. For a bill
