AUTHORS SUBJECT TO CHANGE

AN ACT *to repeal* 66.1010 of the statutes; **relating to:** repealing the prohibition against local governments enacting or enforcing an eviction moratorium on a landlord.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, no city, village, town, or county may enact or enforce an ordinance that imposes a moratorium on a landlord from pursuing an eviction action against a tenant of the landlord's residential or commercial property.

This bill repeals that provision.

Section 1. 66.1010 of the statutes is repealed.
