## 2015 ASSEMBLY BILL 746

January 20, 2016 – Introduced by Representatives GOYKE, BARNES, MACCO, BOWEN, BROSTOFF, HINTZ, SARGENT, OHNSTAD, SPREITZER, SUBECK, KESSLER, RIEMER, MASON, YOUNG, POPE, BERCEAU and SINICKI, cosponsored by Senators C. LARSON, VINEHOUT and HARRIS DODD. Referred to Committee on Corrections.

1     **AN ACT relating to:** creation of a committee to study the model used by the state  
2             of Missouri to provide rehabilitation for juveniles adjudicated delinquent who  
3             are in need of restrictive custodial treatment and to prepare a plan for the  
4             development and implementation of a similar model for the rehabilitation of  
5             such juveniles in this state.

### *Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

This bill requires the secretary of corrections to create a committee to study the model used by the state of Missouri to provide rehabilitation for juveniles adjudicated delinquent who are in need of restrictive custodial treatment and to prepare a plan for the development and implementation of a similar model for the rehabilitation of such juveniles in this state. The study must include recommendations for the establishment of smaller juvenile correctional facilities distributed throughout all geographical areas of the state for the placement of juveniles adjudicated delinquent who are in need of restrictive custodial treatment and of policies that would provide for the placement of such juveniles in facilities closer to their homes, while maintaining the current system of funding those placements through assessments on counties for the costs of those placements under
