3	Whereas, the month of March is Women's History Month and celebrates the
4	significant contributions women of all races, ethnicities, and backgrounds have
5	made to the world; and
6	Whereas, women play a critical role in the vitality and diversity of our
7	communities and are essential to ensuring that Wisconsin is well-represented; and
8	Whereas, while the twentieth century was a pivotal time of growth for women
9	entering politics, women remain underrepresented in male-dominated fields; thus,
10	providing opportunities to support women in public office is imperative; and
11	Whereas, recognizing women in public office will bring awareness to the
12	fundamental necessity of their work and will inspire other young people to serve
13	their communities; now, therefore, be it
14	Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That the legislature
15	hereby proclaims March 19 to be Wisconsin Celebrating Women in Public Office Day
