- 6 Whereas, separated parents who choose to share parenting duties significantly
- 7 decrease the chances of undesirable youth troubles and struggles; and
- 8 Whereas, shared parenting is shown to have a significantly positive effect on
- 9 children's well-being; and
- 10 Whereas, Wisconsin is currently the leading state in shared parenting
- 11 outcomes for children with separated parents; and
- 12 Whereas, increasing the public awareness of the importance of providing
- 13 children with the parental support they need from both parents benefits Wisconsin's
- 14 children, their parents, and all of Wisconsin's citizens; now, therefore, be it
