1 **Relating to:** recognizing the achievements and outstanding service of Herzing
2 University and the Herzing family.

3 Whereas, Herzing University was founded in 1965 as the first post-secondary
4 institution dedicated to preparing students for careers in the computer industry,
5 marking 2015 as the 50th Anniversary of Herzing University's operations; and

6 Whereas, having grown from a single institution in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, to
7 include eleven campuses in eight states in the United States, four of which are in
8 Wisconsin and one being the center for the Online Campus, as well as having four
9 campuses in Canada under the Herzing University name; and

10 Whereas, Herzing University offers more than 50 undergraduate programs,
11 two graduate programs, various continuing education options, and multiple training
12 and certification opportunities; and

13 Whereas, more than 6,000 students attend Herzing University annually, and
14 the System has an alumni community of 45,000 and counting; and
