1 **Relating to:** declaring January 24 to 30, 2021, School Choice Week and recognizing
2 the importance of giving parents the choice in the educational path for their
3 children.

4 Whereas, the school choice program was first launched in Milwaukee in 1990
5 to offer low-income students the opportunity to pick their schools; and

6 Whereas, the Milwaukee Parental Choice Program was the first of its kind in
7 the United States and has since grown to educate more than 28,900 students in 129
8 schools; and

9 Whereas, if the Milwaukee Parental Choice Program was a school district, it
10 would be the second largest in the state; and

11 Whereas, the Wisconsin Legislature expanded school choice to Racine in 2011,
12 statewide in 2013, and to the special needs scholarships in 2015; and

13 Whereas, the statewide and Racine programs educate more than 10,400
14 students in 239 schools; and
