



2013 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 35

May 8, 2013 - Introduced by Representatives BERNARD SCHABER and A. OTT, cosponsored by Senator ELLIS. Referred to Committee on Rules.

1 **Relating to:** declaring Public Works Week.

8 buildings, transportation systems, water supplies, sewage and refuse disposal

10 Whereas, it is beneficial for citizens and civic leaders to learn about and
11 maintain a progressive interest in the public works needs and programs of their
12 communities; and

13 Whereas, the year 2013 marks the 53rd annual National Public Works Week
14 sponsored by the American Public Works Association; now, therefore, be it
