May 31, 2013 – Introduced by Representatives SPIROS, HUTTON, T. LARSON, MURPHY, MURTHA, OHNSTAD, SANFELIPPO, TITTL and BROOKS, cosponsored by Senators VUKMIR, COWLES and L. TAYLOR. Referred to Committee on Rules.

1 **Relating to:** honoring the life and public service of Henry Morris Goldberg.

2 Whereas, Henry Morris “Hank” Goldberg was born July 7, 1936, to Nat and
3 Shirley Goldberg; and

4 Whereas, Hank received his bachelor degree and doctor of medicine degree
5 from Marquette University; and

6 Whereas, Hank joined the United States Army and served as a combat surgeon
7 in the Vietnam War; and

8 Whereas, following his military service, Hank returned to Wisconsin where he
9 joined his father’s medical practice; and

10 Whereas, in 1979 Hank founded Milwaukee Industrial Clinics which expanded
11 to become Occupational Medical Clinics of America; and

12 Whereas, Hank also founded Substance Abuse Management, Inc., which
13 became the world’s largest drug testing company; and

14 Whereas, Hank was a clinical professor for many years and served on the board
15 of directors of the Medical College of Wisconsin; and
