6	Whereas, Bernard John Cigrand, a school teacher in Waubeka, Wisconsin, held
7	the first recognized formal observance of Flag Day at the Stony Hill School; and
8	Whereas, Flag Day gives citizens of the United States an opportunity to
9	rededicate themselves to the ideals of our nation's founding and to consider what the
10	flag of the United States means to them; now, therefore, be it
11	Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That the Wisconsin
12	Legislature recognizes June 14, 2023, to be Flag Day.
