1     **Relating to:** honoring the public service of Police Chief Mike Koval.

2             Whereas, after a long and successful career in public service, Mike Koval, the  
3 chief of the Madison Police Department, retired on September 30, 2019; and

4             Whereas, after graduating from UW-Madison with a degree in journalism,  
5 Koval went on to receive a law degree and also served as an FBI agent for two years;

7             Whereas, Koval first joined the Madison Police Department as an officer in  
8 1983; and

9             Whereas, throughout his long career at MPD, he filled many roles, including  
10 field training supervisor, SWAT hostage negotiator, critical response team  
11 supervisor, primary legal instructor, and sergeant; and

12             Whereas, as the sergeant of recruitment and training for 17 years, Koval  
13 focused on diversifying MPD and hiring and training officers that shared the  
14 department's progressive policing philosophy; and
