1 **Relating to:** establishing special orders of business for Thursday, February 20,
2 2014.

3 ***Resolved by the assembly, That:***

SECTION 1. Special order scheduled. The following proposals shall be special orders of business on Thursday, February 20, 2014, at the times shown:

- (1) At 1:01 a.m., 2013 Assembly Bill 417, or 2013 Senate Bill 318, if it is in the Assembly, relating to: authorizing the city of Milwaukee to sell eligible school facilities to eligible purchasers.
- (2) At 1:02 a.m., 2013 Assembly Bill 556, relating to: strip searches.
- (3) At 1:03 a.m., 2013 Assembly Bill 618, relating to: the student information system, the disclosure of personally identifiable student data, and the disclosure of pupil records.
- (4) At 1:04 a.m., 2013 Assembly Bill 690, relating to: reporting registration and voting statistics.
- (5) At 1:05 a.m., 2013 Assembly Bill 744, relating to: licenses for new dairy plants, food warehouses, food processing plants, retail food establishments, and meat establishments.
- (6) At 1:06 a.m., 2013 Assembly Bill 745, relating to: milk procurement fees.

- (7) At 1:07 a.m., 2013 Assembly Bill 746, relating to: limits on liability for persons offering agricultural tourism activities.
- (8) At 1:08 a.m., 2013 Assembly Bill 750, relating to: preemption of local ordinances that require employees of a local governmental unit, employees of a contractor of a local governmental unit, or employees who perform work funded by a local governmental unit to be paid at a minimum wage rate specified in the ordinance and preemption of residency requirements for laborers, workers, mechanics, and truck drivers employed on local projects of public works to which the prevailing wage law applies.

SECTION 2. Twelve hour notice. Consideration of the special order of business established in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall occur at the time shown in that section or 12 hours after adoption of this resolution, whichever is later.
