



2013 ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION 26

February 20, 2014 – Introduced by Representatives SHANKLAND, JORGENSEN, BARCA, HESSELBEIN, JOHNSON, DOYLE, KAHL, WACHS, SINICKI, CLARK, C. TAYLOR, MILROY, BEWLEY, VRUWINK, PASCH, SARGENT, WRIGHT, BILLINGS, SMITH, ZEPNICK and ZAMARRIPA.

1 **Relating to:** requiring the speaker of the assembly to appoint a special committee
2 on clean energy.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

The resolution requires the speaker of the assembly to immediately appoint a special committee on clean energy, consisting of an equal number of majority and minority party members, to devise ways to facilitate the development of clean energy solutions, create jobs while reducing pollution, move Wisconsin away from fossil fuel-based energy production, and prevent foreign nations from dominating the clean energy field.

Under the resolution, the committee must deliver its findings to the speaker and the assembly before February 1, 2014.

3 **Resolved by the assembly, That** the speaker of the assembly shall
4 immediately appoint a special committee on clean energy, consisting of an equal
5 number of members of the majority and minority parties, to devise ways to facilitate
6 the development of clean energy solutions, create jobs while reducing pollution, move
7 Wisconsin away from fossil fuel-based energy production, and prevent foreign

1 nations from dominating the clean energy field. The committee shall deliver its
2 findings to the speaker and the assembly before February 1, 2014.
